An@tomy.tv contains detailed 3D computer graphic models and animations of the human anatomy. Models can be rotated and layers of anatomy can be added or removed.

Getting Started

1. Open **Internet Explorer**. Go to the Library & Information Services website at <http://lis.tees.ac.uk>
2. Select **E-Resources via Search It** from the menu on the left side of the screen.
3. The **Search It** window will open. Click on **Find Databases**.
4. Select the initial letter of the database you want from the **A-Z list** e.g. **A** for **An@tomy.tv**
5. Scroll down to the database you want and click on the link (the link is the name of the database).

Off-campus access: follow steps 1 to 4 above.

Click on the  icon, then on the link next to **How to Access** and follow the instructions for off-campus access. You will need your ICT username and password (same as your Blackboard username and password).

6. At the **Welcome to Ovid Online** Page click on **Continue**.
7. At the next screen click on the link **Primal Pictures** on the blue banner. **An@tomy.tv** will open.

Opening a Module

- You have access to all the products in bold with a green tick next to them.
- Click on a product to open it in a new window e.g. **Head & Neck**.
- A **Getting Started** pop-up appears.
 - For a brief tutorial to help you get started using An@tomy.tv click on **GO** next to **Getting Started movie: Product Overview**.
 - Close the pop-up to view the Anatomy module.
- A **3D model** is displayed on the left of the screen.
- Rotate the **3D model** using the **Arrows** beneath the image.
- Strip away or build up the anatomical layers using the **layer controls** beneath the image.



- To **print** or **save** the image, select from the options beneath the image.
- **Left click** on a specific area of the model to display the **text** that relates to that area on the right side of the screen.
- **Click** on the links in the text to view **images, animations** or **further information**.
- Different views can be selected from the **3D Anatomy View List** on the right side of the screen.

MRI

- Use the **MRI** button to view slices through parts of the 3D model.
- While the MRI slice is displayed you can still use the arrows for rotation and the layer controls underneath the image.

Slides

- Click on the **Slides button** to view a wide variety of illustrations and photographs.
- To view a slide, click on a folder or folder name and choose which slide you want to display.

Movies

- The movies tab contains the following categories:
 - Biomechanics
 - Surface anatomy
- Click on a movie title on the right of the screen – the movie will play on the left.

- On the homepage select the **Student Area** from the tabs underneath the **An@tomy.tv banner** at the top of the screen. Instructions and product sheets are available to help you use An@tomy.tv.
