An@tomy.tv contains detailed 3D computer graphic models and animations of the human anatomy. Models can be rotated and layers of anatomy can be added or removed.

Getting Started

1. Open **Internet Explorer**. Go to the Library & Information Services website at <http://lis.tees.ac.uk>
2. Select **E-Resources via Search It** from the menu on the left side of the screen.
3. The **Search It** window will open. Click on **Find Databases**.
4. Select the initial letter of the database you want from the **A-Z list** e.g. **A** for **Anatomy.tv**
5. Scroll down to the database you want and click on the link (the link is the name of the database).

Off-campus access: follow steps **1 to 4** above.

Click on the  icon, then on the link next to **How to Access** and follow the instructions for off-campus access. You will need your ICT username and password (same as your Blackboard username and password).

6. At the Ovid Online News Page click on **Continue**.
7. At the **Select a Database** screen, click on **Anatomy.tv** to open the database.

Opening a Module

- You have access to all the products in bold with a green tick next to them.
- Click on a product to open it in a new window e.g. **Head & Neck**.
- A **3D model** is displayed on the left of the screen.
- Rotate the **3D model** using the **Arrows** beneath the image.
- Strip away or build up the anatomical layers using the **layer controls** beneath the image.
- To **save**, **print** or **email** the image, **right click** on the image and choose from the options.
- **Left click** on a specific area of the model to display the **text** that relates to that area on the right side of the screen.
- **Click** on the links in the text to view **images**, **animations** or **further information**.



Contents

- Use the **CONTENTS** button above the 3D image to view the folders where all of the contents of this module are filed.
- To watch videos or view slides open the required folder then click on the video or slide icon.

MRI

- Use the **MRI** button to view slices through parts of the 3D model.
- While the MRI slice is displayed you can still use the arrows for rotation and the layer controls underneath the image.

Quiz

- Select the **QUIZ** and **MCQ** buttons to test your knowledge of the model displayed.

Radiology

- Some of the modules have a **RADIOLOGY** button. Select this button to display radiology notes.
